58th Annual Broward Shell Club Show Rules

GENERAL RULES – Applicable to both scientific and artistic division exhibits

Please read entire entry packet carefully!

1. The Broward Shell Club invites you to enter our Shell Show by submitting this application for receipt no later than Thursday, November 30, 2024. **Space is limited and entries will be considered on a first come basis.**
2. Set-up for exhibitors will be from 3:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Thursday, January 23, 2025, and on Friday, January 24, 2025 from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. All exhibits must be in place by **Friday, January 24th at 2:00 pm.** No items may be added or removed from exhibits after judging begins at 2 pm on Friday.
3. No exhibits or portions of an exhibit may be removed before 4:00 pm on Sunday, January 26, 2025. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
4. Judging will begin at 2:00 pm on January 24. The auditorium will be closed during judging. Any exhibitor entering the hall during the judging risks having their exhibit disqualified.
5. The Shell Show is open to the public on Saturday from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm and Sunday from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.
6. Only exhibits entered for the competition will be eligible for awards and trophies. However, non-competitive exhibits are also welcome. All exhibits must be titled, and titles must be listed on your applications.
7. Exhibitors may enter as many exhibits as desired (space permitting) but may only enter one exhibit in each individual category. A grouping of items (particularly shell craft) will be considered as one entry and will be judged as such.
8. During the judging, the name or any other identifying information of the exhibitor **MUST** be concealed in the exhibit.
9. The age of all Student exhibitors must be on their exhibits. Placards will be placed on the exhibits following judging with the exhibitor and Category name.
10. No specimen shell exhibit case or Sea Art and Shell Craft base shall exceed 30" from front to back due to table size restrictions. The height may not exceed 36" from table surface to top edge unless approved by Shell Show Chair(s). Wall hung exhibits must be hung with wire on peg hook provided by exhibitor.
11. If upright backing or screens are used, the reverse side must be pleasing to the eye and must not detract in any way from the display on the opposite side of the table.
12. Multiple signs, cards, narrative, photographs, or drawings shall not exceed the 36" height rule unless approved by Shell Show Chair(s). References used in identifications and for other scientific information may be placed in the cases or at the end of the exhibit (**please include in overall length**). We suggest including information which helps explain or makes the exhibit more interesting to the public.

13. The ENTRY COMMITTEE, consisting of the Shell Show Chair(s), the Judges and the President of Broward Shell Club, Inc., reserve the right to refuse entry and/or to change the category of an exhibit if, in their opinion, it is better suited for a category other than the category in which it was entered.
- 14. Individual exhibit length is limited to 32' maximum length due to facility constraints.** Exhibits may wrap at the ends of tables depending on the final layout.
15. No exhibit that has won a first-place ribbon in a previous Broward Shell Show may compete again in the same class unless 50% of the exhibit, including graphics, is new.
16. No advertising or selling will be permitted in or about any exhibit during the show: with one exception. A professional artistic category exhibitor, after judging and starting on Saturday morning, may display business cards (business cards only, please) in front of or beside their exhibit by submitting a registration fee of \$25 with their exhibit registration or the Show Chair(s) may approve an exhibitor displaying business cards during the show after paying a \$25 registration fee.
17. No rule may be waived except by the Shell Show Chair(s).
18. Neither the E. Pat Larkins Community Center nor the Broward Shell Club, Inc. will be responsible for damages, theft, or loss to any exhibit. However, every effort will be made to safeguard exhibits.
- 19. The decision of the judges will be final.**
20. Any unsportsmanlike conduct on the part of any exhibitor will result in immediate expulsion from the present show by the ENTRY COMMITTEE and prohibition by the Board of Directors from entering the Broward Shell Show for a minimum of one year.

SCIENTIFIC RULES

1. All exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor. Borrowed shells, photographs, and/or sea art items may be included in "In Any Manner" exhibits only if the owner is identified.
2. All scientific/specimen shell exhibits must be displayed in cases constructed of wood or other material of equal stability. They must be covered with glass, Plexiglas, or other attractive transparent material. Plastic wrap will not be allowed. Exhibitor's name shall not appear on any exhibit until after judging.
3. All specimens shall be labeled with full scientific name (Genus, species or subspecies, author, date) and locality where collected as shown in the example below.
 - a. GENUS & SPECIES: Latin or Latinized names, underlined **or** *italic*. Genus name capitalized.
 - b. Species name not capitalized. Leave space between genus and species name as shown below.
 - c. Author & Date: The person who first described and named the species and the year of authorship.
 - d. When author and date are in parenthesis, it means that the species has been reclassified into a genus different from the one in which the author originally placed it.

Example:

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ARTISTIC RULES

1. No Shell Craft case shall exceed 30" from front to back due to table size restrictions. The height may not exceed 36" from table surface to top edge.
2. Exhibits shall be entirely the work of exhibitor(s). Sailor's Valentine and Sewing/Needlepoint hobbyist categories allow kits if they are identified as such on your registration form.
3. **No kits are allowed in any professional category.**
4. Exhibit collaborators: please list all names on the entry form.
5. Wall hung exhibits must be hung with wire on peg hook. Exhibitor must provide his/her own means of hanging to peg board. No saw tooth hangers are permitted.
6. Exhibitors shall provide any needed easel, stand, etc. for tabletop exhibits and 12-foot extension cord for electrical exhibits.
7. A professional exhibitor is one who has sold, or offered for sale, his/her work through galleries, shops, home or other outlets whether he/she has a tax number and regardless of total sales volume or income.
8. A professional exhibitor may exhibit in a hobbyist class provided that the hobbyist exhibit is in a medium that is substantially and clearly different from the exhibitor's medium or media. For example: someone who has made and sold sailor's valentines, mosaics and/or flowers but has never sold photographs or needlework, must enter his/her valentine, mosaic or flower in a professional class but may enter his/her photograph or needlework in a hobbyist class.
9. Traditional Sailor's Valentine. Design to be created in the traditional mosaic style – may have flat geometric patterns – may have some flowers. The majority of shells used to be classic types that were utilized in older valentines. For example: bubble, chiton, crab's eye, rose cup, keyhole limpet, Janthina, green nerite, rice, spirula, sunrise tellin, trivia, etc. Please refer to "Sailors' Valentines" written by John Fondas.

JUDGING CRITERIA

All Exhibits at the Broward Shell Club, Inc. Annual Shell Show will be judged by our Judges, in accordance with the recommended standards for judging as outlined in the American Conchologist, March 2001 issue.

DEFINITIONS:

1. **Student:** from Grade K though **COLLEGE**.
2. **Novice Scientific Exhibitor:** Any person over the age of 18, who has not exhibited in a recognized shell show prior to the current Shell Show season. This category applies to the first year of exhibition only. (Honor system)
3. **Novice Artist:** Any person over the age of 18 exhibiting Sea Art or Shell Craft who has not exhibited in a recognized shell show prior to the current Shell Show season. This category applies to the first year of exhibition only. (Honor system)
4. **Professional Artistic Exhibitor:** One who has sold, or offered for sale, his/her work through galleries, shops, home, or other outlets whether he/she has a tax number and regardless of total sales volume or income.
5. **Self-collected** means personally collected by the exhibitor while beach walking, snorkeling, scuba diving, etc.
NOTE: A ★ star must be placed, uniformly, on the label for each self-collected shell (unless in self-collected category) to be eligible for any self-collected award.

13. FLORIDA / CARIBBEAN - Self-collected
14. FLORIDA / CARIBBEAN - Any Manner
15. ONE FAMILY - MAJOR - Any Manner judged on completeness of family representation. This category shall include: Muricidae, Conidae, Cypraeidae, Volutidae, Strombidae and Pectinidae.
16. ONE FAMILY - MINOR - Any Manner judged on completeness of family representation. This category includes all families not listed in #15 above.
17. ONE GENUS - Any Manner - Some families are considered to have only one genus, such as Conidae or Cypraeidae. These must be shown in Category #15. If desired, sub-genera may be exhibited in this category.
18. ONE SPECIES - Any Manner - The purpose of this category is to present a complete representation of the species rather than a large quantity of shells.
19. SINGLE SHELL WORLDWIDE - Self-collected
20. SINGLE SHELL WORLDWIDE - Any Manner
21. SINGLE SHELL FOSSIL - Self-collected
22. SINGLE SHELL FOSSIL - Any Manner
23. ABBERANT SHELLS - Any Manner - Shells having an anomaly or freak condition
24. TRUE MINIATURES - Any Manner - Adult shells which are less than 1" (2.5 cm)
25. FOSSILS - Any Manner
26. LAND or FRESH WATER SHELLS - Any Manner
27. SEA LIFE - Other than mollusks. This category is for crustaceans, echinoderms, brachiopods, etc., living or preserved. Identification is required.
28. SUPER 10 - Any exhibit of specimen shells not exceeding 10 feet in length.
29. BEACH SHELLS - Self-collected - Shells obtained by the exhibitor on the beach, from wading, or from beach restoration projects. None should be obtained by snorkeling, scuba diving or any other 'wet' method.
30. EDUCATIONAL
The objective of this category is to teach or inform about the Phylum Mollusca. The exhibit could cover morphology, range locality, ecology, etc. It may include models, photographs, illustrations, growth series, etc. For example, it may include stories of shells in art, architecture, commerce, literature or items found in archaeological digs. The exhibit must include substantially more educational information than scientific/specimen shell labeling.
31. **"BEST OF THE BEST"**
Only an exhibit that has won a MAJOR award(s) in any previous show may be entered in this category and the exhibit may not be entered into any other category at the show. The exhibits entered in this category will **not** be eligible for any trophy or award at this show other than the "Best of the Best" Trophy.

2025 AWARDS – SCIENTIFIC DIVISION

1. **AMERICAN MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY AWARD** - To be presented to the exhibit that, in the opinion of the Judges, displays overall excellence. A beautiful plaque is awarded to the winner.
2. **CONCHOLOGISTS OF AMERICA AWARD** - A plaque presented by the COA to the scientific exhibit that shows overall excellence and best furthers interest in shells and shell collecting. It may be given only to a blue-ribbon winning exhibit that has not been awarded another major award in the present show. Dealers are not eligible for this award unless the exhibit is of self-collected shells.
3. **THE DuPONT AWARD** - A plaque to be presented by the Delaware Museum of Natural History to the outstanding exhibit of mollusks judged as contributing the most to the success of the show and is most instructive and inspiring to visitors because of its attractiveness, educational value and scientific accuracy. It may be given only to a blue-ribbon winning exhibit that has not been awarded another major award in the present show. Dealers are not eligible for this award.
4. **“BEST OF THE BEST”** - A trophy presented to the exhibit which, in the opinion of the Judges, is the best of all the previous major trophy winners entered solely in this category. **Entry does not qualify for any other awards / ribbons.**
5. **LEN HILL MEMORIAL TROPHY** - A trophy presented to the exhibit that, in the opinion of the Judges, represents the most beautiful exhibit.
6. **SHELL OF SHOW - Self Collected** - A trophy awarded to a shell chosen from any exhibit entered in Categories 1-33 and/or those shell specimens so identified by a star in other than self-collected categories. To be awarded for rarity and condition of specimen. *Best of the Best exhibits are not eligible for consideration.*
7. **SHELL OF SHOW - Any Manner** - A trophy to be chosen from any exhibit, including self-collected, in categories 1-33. To be awarded for rarity and condition of specimen. *Best of the Best exhibits are not eligible for consideration.*
8. **PHYLLIS DIEGEL MEMORIAL FOSSIL SHELL OF SHOW** – Any manner – A trophy awarded to the best single fossil shell.
9. **JIM VUNKANNON MEMORIAL FLORIDA / CARIBBEAN TROPHY** - Presented to the exhibit that, in the opinion of the Judges, represents the best exhibit of shells from Florida and the Caribbean.
10. **GERRIT DeGRAAFF MEMORIAL TROPHY** – Presented to a single shell that, in the opinion of the Judges, represents a large and exceptional specimen of a chosen species. The Judges will be looking at size and quality for this specimen that reflects Mr. DeGraaff’s love for outstanding, sizable specimen shells.
11. **NEIL HEPLER MEMORIAL TROPHY FOR EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE** - Presented to the exhibit that, in the opinion of the Judges, displays outstanding educational value. This award will not be restricted to the Educational Categories but will embrace all categories.
12. **RICHARD DUERR MEMORIAL BEST FOSSIL EXHIBIT TROPHY** - Presented to the exhibit that, in the opinion of the Judges, represents the best fossil exhibit.
13. **BEST STUDENT EXHIBITOR TROPHY - SCIENTIFIC**
14. **BETTY HAMANN MEMORIAL BEST SEA LIFE TROPHY** - Presented to the exhibit that, in the opinion of the Judges, represents the best sea life exhibit.
15. **PEOPLE’S CHOICE AWARD – SCIENTIFIC (As voted by the attendance)**
16. **BEST BEGINNING SCIENTIFIC EXHIBITOR**

RIBBONS: First Place - Blue, Second Place - Red, Third Place - White, and Special Merit (at Judge’s discretion)

- H4. PICTURE OR MOSAIC – Must be 6" or less in diameter, length or width. Tabletop only.
- H5. FLOWER ARRANGEMENT – Must be 6" or less in diameter, length or width. Tabletop only.
- H6. PICTURE OR MOSAIC - Greater than 6" in diameter, length or width. Wall hung or table top.
- H7. FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS - Greater than 6" in diameter, length or width. Tabletop only.
- SAILOR'S VALENTINE (Kits are allowed in the Hobbyist category but must be identified on entry form)**
- H8. Single - Octagonal case - Must contain shells and/or sea life – Max. 32 in x 32 in Tabletop only
- H9. Traditional Single - Octagonal case - Shells and/or sea life. Max. 14 in x 14 in Tabletop only (See rule #31)
- H10. Double - Pair of hinged octagonal cases - Heart and flowers on one side and sentimental message on the other side. - Tabletop only - Max 20 in x 40 in.
- H11. Traditional Double - Pair of hinged octagonal cases. - Sentimental message - Shells or sea life - Tabletop only - Max 20 in. X 40 in. (See rule #31 for details)
- H12. MIRROR - Shells, fossil shells and/or other sea life - Max 30 in high and 24 in wide - Wall hung only
- H13. DÉCOR - WALL HUNG ONLY. Wreaths, hangings, mobiles, etc. Max 30 in high and 24 in wide.
- H14. LAMP – Single Lamp. Shells and/or sea related material. Maximum 24" wide. Tabletop only.
- H15. TREE or TOPIARY – Single non-holiday tree or topiary. Tabletop only.
- H16. SHELL BOX, CHEST or any ENCRUSTED TABLETOP ITEM (i.e., birdhouses, letters, etc.) Tabletop only.
- H17. SHELL TABLES or TRAYS - Must be decorated with shells or shell/sea life table.
- H18. PHOTOGRAPHY – Exhibit is limited to a framed area of 2' x 4', single or multiple photos. Subject matter must pertain to mollusks or sea life. Photographs may be commercially processed and printed but must have been taken by the competitor. Exhibitors must provide hanging wire or hook or table easel. Conceal exhibitor's name until after judging.
- H19. PAINTING or DRAWINGS – May be oil, watercolor, acrylics, ink, pencil or charcoal. Exhibit is limited to a framed area of 2' x 4'; single or multiple paintings or drawings executed by the exhibitor. Subject matter must pertain to mollusks, or those invertebrates identified in Category 30 Sea Life. Exhibitors must provide hanging wire or hook or table easel. Conceal exhibitor's name until after judging.
- H20. SEASHELL JEWELRY and PERSONAL ACCESSORY – Single piece or matched set in a covered case.
- H21. SEASHELL JEWELRY and PERSONAL ACCESSORIES – Collection of multiple unmatched pieces in a case.
- H22. NOVELTIES - Animals, caricatures, dolls, chess sets, etc.
- H23. HOLIDAY THEMES - Any holiday theme of your choice. Tabletop only.
- H24. SEWING or NEEDLEWORK - (by hand or sewing machine) needlepoint, quilting, knitting, etc.
Kits are allowed in the Hobbyist Category
- H25. SPECIAL - Any item not fitting the above categories H4-H21.

2025 PROFESSIONAL EXHIBIT CATEGORIES – ARTISTIC DIVISION

All professional entries must be created entirely by the exhibitor. No kits allowed.

- P1. PICTURE OR MOSAIC - 6" or less in diameter, length or width. Tabletop only.
- P2. FLOWER ARRANGEMENT - 6" or less in diameter, length or width. Tabletop only.
- P3. PICTURE OR MOSAIC - Greater than 6" in diameter, length or width. Wall hung or tabletop.
- P4. FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS - Greater than 6" in diameter, length or width. Tabletop only.
SAILOR'S VALENTINE (no kits) –
- P5. Single - Octagonal case - Shells and/or sea life - Max 32 in x 32 in Tabletop only.
- P6. Traditional Single - Octagonal case - Shells and/or sea life. Max 14 in x 14 in Tabletop only. (See rule #31 for details)
- P7. Double - Pair of hinged octagonal cases - Heart and flowers on one side and sentimental message on the other side. - Tabletop only - Max 20 in x 40 in
- P8. Traditional Double - Pair of hinged octagonal cases. - Sentimental message - Shells or sea life -Tabletop only - Max 20 in. X 40 in (See rule #31 for details)
- P9. MIRROR - Shells, fossil shells and/or other sea life - Max 30 in high and 24 in wide - Wall hung only
- P10. DÉCOR - WALL HUNG ONLY. Wreaths, hangings, mobiles, etc. Max 30 in high and 24 in wide.
- P11. LAMP – Single Lamp. Shells and/or sea related material. Maximum 24" wide. Tabletop only.
- P12. TREE or TOPIARY – Single non-holiday tree or topiary. Tabletop only.
- P13. SHELL BOX, CHEST or any ENCRUSTED TABLETOP ITEM (i.e., birdhouses, letters, etc.) Tabletop only.
- P14. SHELL TABLES or TRAYS - Must be decorated with shells or sea life.
- P15. PHOTOGRAPHY – Exhibit is limited to a framed area of 2' x 4', single or multiple photos. Subject matter must pertain to mollusks or sea life. Photographs may be commercially processed and printed but must have been taken by the competitor. Exhibitors must provide hanging wire or hook or table easel. Conceal exhibitor's name until after judging.
- P16. PAINTING or DRAWINGS – May be oil, watercolor, acrylics, ink, pencil or charcoal. Exhibit is limited to a framed area of 2' x 4'; single or multiple paintings or drawings executed by the exhibitor. Subject matter must pertain to mollusks, or those invertebrates identified in Category 30 Sea Life. Exhibitor must provide hanging wire or hook or table easel. Conceal exhibitor's name until after judging.
- P17. SEASHELL JEWELRY and PERSONAL ACCESSORY – Single piece or matched set in a covered case.
- P18. SEASHELL JEWELRY and PERSONAL ACCESSORIES – Collection of multiple unmatched pieces in a covered case.
- P19. NOVELTIES - Animals, caricatures, dolls, chess sets, etc.
- P20. HOLIDAY THEMES - Any holiday theme of your choice. Tabletop only.
- P21. SEWING or NEEDLEWORK - (by hand or sewing machine) needlepoint, quilting, knitting, etc.
Kits are allowed in the Hobbyist Category
- P22. SPECIAL - Any item not fitting the above categories P4-P21.

2025 COLLECTIBLES EXHIBIT CLASSES – ARTISTIC DIVISION

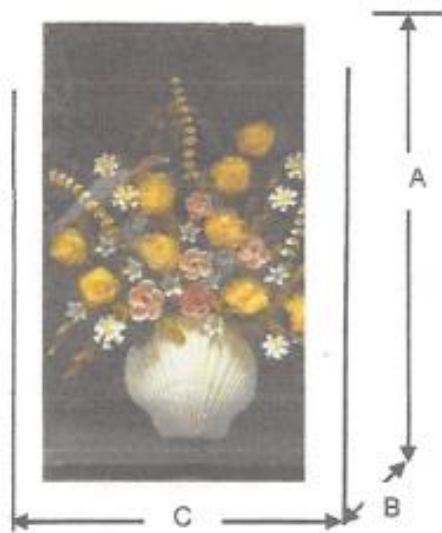

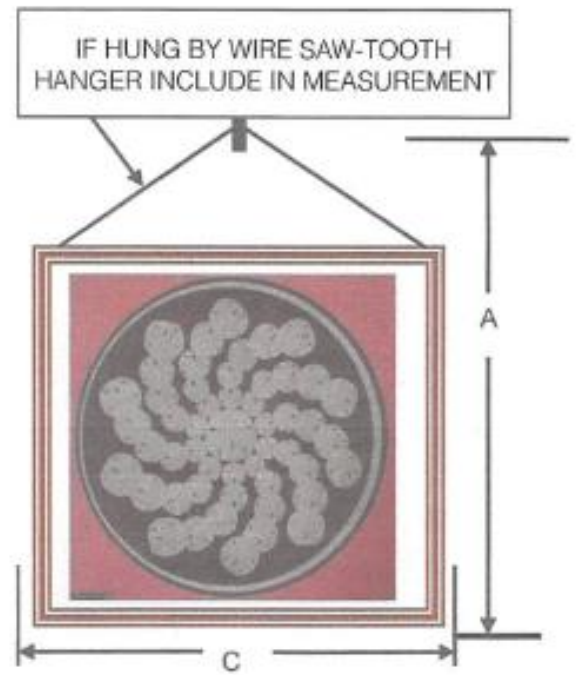
